Homework Overview

Compulsory Homework

Children should read at home at least 3 times a week and this should be signed by an adult at home. In Upper Key Stage 2, this does not need to be aloud to an adult but we recommend that you ask questions about what they have read.

Recommended Homework

Children need a rapid recall of times tables so we recommend the use of TT Rock Stars at home to practise this. We also recommend the use of Spelling Shed to practise their weekly spelling rule. This is linked with the rule they learn in class and changes weekly.



Catch-Up Learning

As the children have had a disruptive year, we are providing extra homework that will aim to close gaps in their learning due to missed time at school. This is linked to the class homework sheet on the class page, with things you can do at home, you could post this on your child's seesaw account for their teacher to see. The class teacher will also post a piece of homework on Seesaw that your child can complete.

Optional Learning

These are extra challenges that you can complete at home and these can be done together as a family. These could be family challenges on twitter, house challenges, black history month challenges or competitions. This could also be the topic ideas listed on the homework page for your class.
