

Happy New Year, from the team in Reception!

We are extremely proud of how all the children have settled into Reception, how they have learnt the routines and how they have all made lots of new friends. The children have made great progress with their learning as well as developing their social, emotional and personal skills. Last term, it was brilliant to see the children participate in lots of great activities.

This term, we will be exploring different types of journeys and transport. We would love to see pictures of the children's journeys outside of school. Please send pictures into Seesaw to spark discussion in class. We will be focusing on fiction and non-fiction books including, *We're Going on a Bear Hunt*, *Getting Around Through the Years*, *The Train Ride*, and many more! We will be comparing transport vehicles from the past, discussing our own journeys (to school, a walk to the park, going on holiday) and learning about special people who help us for example, the police.

Reading at home is vitally important to help your child progress and become a lover of reading. The children will continue to take reading books home on Wednesday and will need to return them by the following Monday. You will need to listen to your child read at least 3 times a week and record in their reading diary each week. This will then be checked by the class teacher.

We visit the library every Wednesday. The children independently choose a book to take home to read that week, please ensure library books are brought back to school ahead of Wednesday's library visit. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact a member of the Reception team.
