Year 6 SATs Week 11th-14th May

Year 6 SATs week will take place **week commencing 11th May!**

SATs test the National Primary Curriculum, which has been taught in school. The tests are marked externally and children will receive their results in July. Please ensure your child is in attendance and punctual on these days.

Children will be invited into school from 8am for a free breakfast of that week Monday to Thursday.

Y4 Multiplication Check

Children in Y4 will be taking the statutory multiplication tables check (MTC) next half term. They are busy practising in school. Please can you encourage your child to practice their times tables at home.

May Census and Special Lunch menu

On **Thursday 21st May** school completes a Census on pupil statistics for the Government. This process happens three times a year and directly affects our funding. If you think you are entitled to make an application for Free School Meals, then please contact the school office and we can support you with this.

You can apply for school meals if you receive:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, provided they are not receiving Working Tax Credit
- the 'Guaranteed' element of the State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income threshold of less than £7,400 You can apply online at: <https://www.bradford.gov.uk/benefits/applying-for-benefits/free-school-meals/is>
